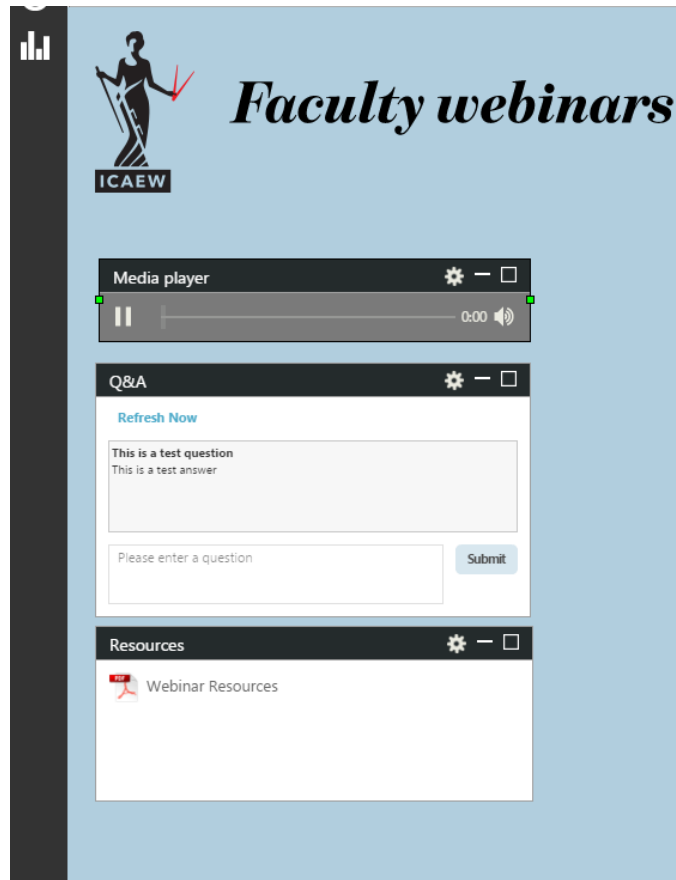

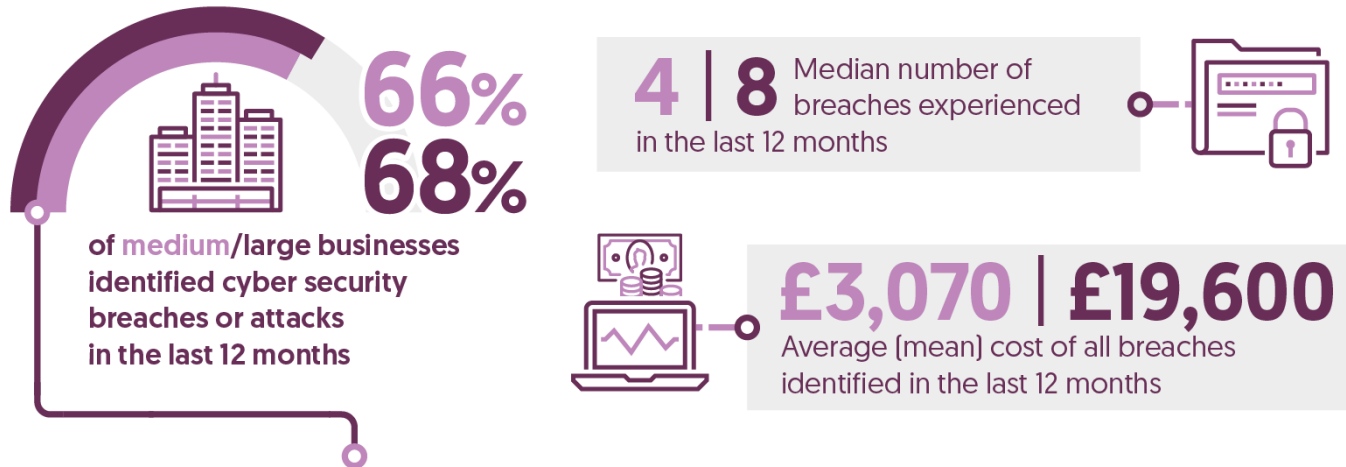

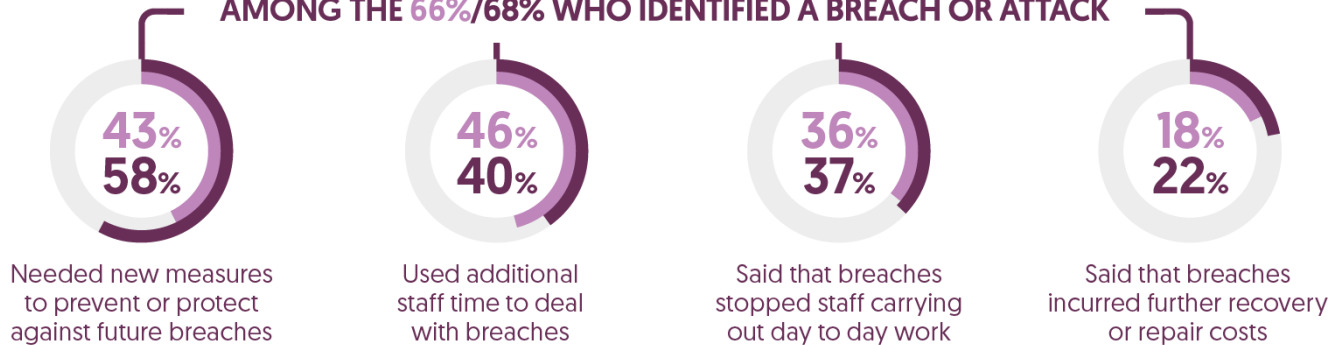
# Why is cyber security important?

### AMONG THE 66%/68% WHO IDENTIFIED A BREACH OR ATTACK



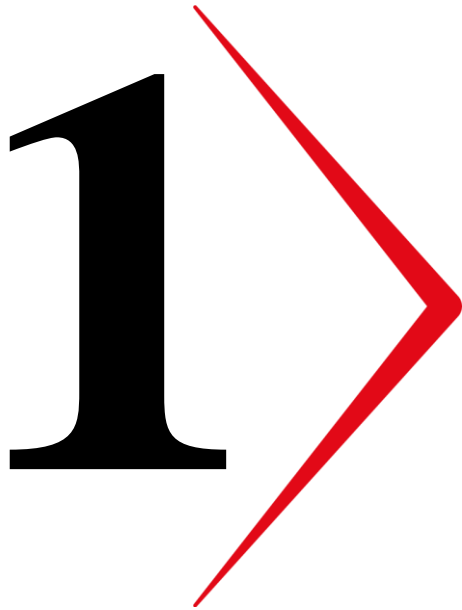


## *Why is cyber security important?*

Confidentiality, reputation and business risk

Awareness, technology and processes will help protect that reputation. Communication plan

# *Passwords*



## *Pass phrase in place of pass word*

- Complex pass phrases
- Use two factor authentication (2FA)
- Change defaults
- Don't reuse
- Don't share
- NCSC advice – “ensure you understand the impact of complex passwords on staff”
- Password managers are good

Pa55w0rd1 is not  
enough

# *Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)*



## *Bring your own security exposure*

- End point security
- Separation of work and home
- Cost reduction v. management cost
- Acceptable use policies

# *Data leakage*



## *Data will leak*

- Mobile storage is ubiquitous
- Shadow IT use of cloud services
- Social media
- Mobile devices
- Suppliers
- Control access and monitor
- Policies in place
- Staff awareness

# *Ransomware*



## *Is not the end of the world*

- Be suspicious!
- Install updates
- Keep backups and regularly test backups!
- Use anti-malware software
- Disable macros from running automatically
- Least privilege access

## *Organisational boundaries*

- Organisations extend beyond traditional boundaries
- Verification of cloud services remains challenging
- TalkTalk, Debenhams Flowers, Target

Increased peace of mind

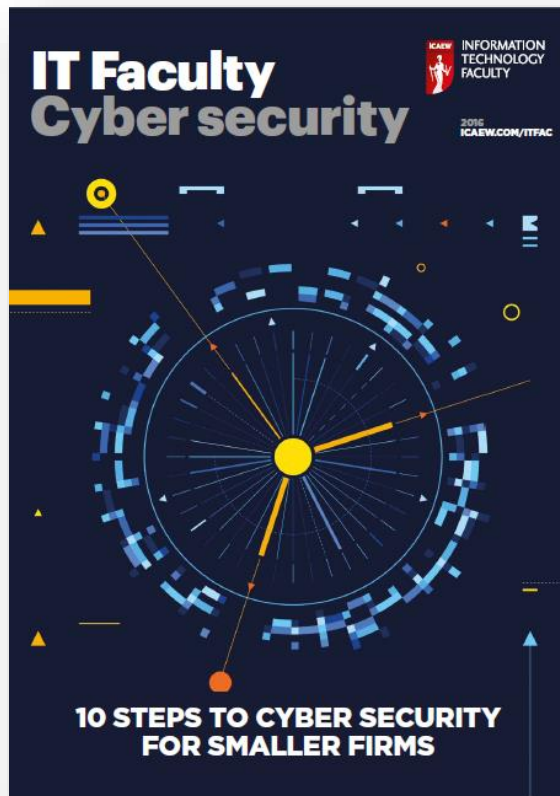
Reduced business risk

# *10 Steps to Cyber Security for Smaller Firms*



**1** Allocate responsibilities

**2** Protect your computers and your network

**3** Keep your computers up to date

**4** Control employee access to computers and documents

**5** Protect against viruses

**6** Extend security beyond the office

**7** Don't forget disks and drives

**8** Plan for the worst

**9** Educate your team

**10** Keep records - and test your security

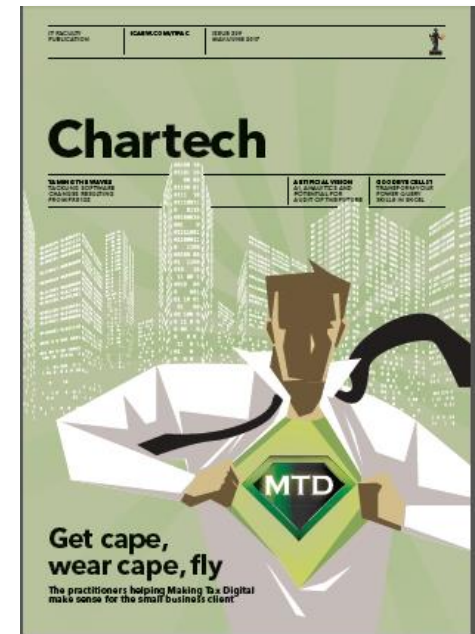
