Contracts of employment



- A contract of employment is an agreement between an employer and employee
- A written statement sets out the main terms and conditions of employment
- Pay, hours and holidays form part of the contract of employment
- Contracts can be varied by the mutual agreement of both parties

- Individual written pay slip or statement
- National living or national minimum wage
- Deductions form wages
- Automatic pension enrolment



Hours of work

- Limit of average 48 hours per week
- 11 consecutive hours rest in any 24 hour period
- One day off each week
- A limit on night workers
- Additional rights for young workers



- 5.6 weeks of paid leave a year
- Employers can set the times when workers can take their leave
- No legal right to paid public holidays
